Plan Markings

This bulletin explains the various markings that are used to track deposited plans, strata plans and primary applications in their progress from lodgment to issue of new folios of the Register. This process involves a number of stages, including assembly and noting; allocation and, for primary applications, examination of the chain of title; examination; and registration and issue of new folios of the Register.

The plan is being noted and assembled prior to examination.


The plan is awaiting allocation to the examining officer, or title deed examination for a primary application.
