LOCAL COMMUNITY MEMBER APPOINTED TO TULLY PARK GOLF COURSE TRUST

Minister for Lands, Tony Kelly, today announced the appointment of community members to manage the Tully Park golf course in Goulburn.

“I congratulate Charles McDonald, Anthony Anable and Brian Larkin as the new members of the golf course trust,” Mr Kelly said.

“I also congratulate Ian Ison, Carol Scott, Kevin Gann and David King on their reappointment to the trust.

“The Rees Government is very grateful for the efforts of all the trust members who help manage some of the 33,000 Crown reserves across NSW”, Mr Kelly said.

Duty MLC for Goulburn, Mick Veitch, said around 750 reserves are looked after by community volunteers, who help care for valuable local infrastructure such as public halls, parks and reserves, swimming pools and smaller sportsgrounds.

“These trust members have the skills, experience and enthusiasm, to back the NSW Government in working hard to protect important community assets and encourage people to use them.

“I put the call out for everyone in the local community to seriously consider getting involved with a local trust”, Mr Veitch said.

Mr Kelly said trust members are also eligible for the annual Lands Crown Reserve Trust Award which recognises the important work trust members do for the community.”
