ULLADULLA HARBOUR REPAIRS UNDERWAY

Minister for Lands, Tony Kelly, today advised that repair works to the tuna wharf at Ulladulla are continuing this week.

“Following further investigations last week, work has now begun to remove and replace the subsided concrete.

“It is anticipated that the work will be completed by the end of next week.

“Investigations did not reveal any significant structural problems with the wharf and it will return to full operation upon completion of the repair works.

“Meanwhile, preliminary geotechnical investigations into the feasibility of a potential site for a floating pontoon in the harbour were also undertaken last week.

“Lands will continue discussions with stakeholders, including council and NSW Maritime, to explore possible options for the pontoon.

“I can assure the local community that Lands will continue to carry out its maintenance and management responsibilities to ensure assets remain serviceable and safe for the benefit of the local community.
